September 30, 2025, at 5:00 PM

The meeting was called to order at 5:00PM. The minutes from August 4, 2025, were approved with no changes.

Chief Wallace provided an update on the Summer Safety Corridor initiative. Overall, the program has been viewed as a success—both in raising community awareness and in collecting data to better understand traffic patterns along Ridge Road. With the installation of new speed signs, the department now has statistical data on vehicle speeds, showing that the overwhelming majority of drivers are complying with the posted 35 MPH limit.

The committee discussed the plan to relocate the speed signs periodically to collect comparable data from additional areas, including Section Road, Galbraith Road, and nearby neighborhoods.

Chief Wallace also presented a department update, highlighting the continued success of the Flock camera system and reviewing officer training policies. These policies emphasize ongoing preparedness and vigilance to ensure readiness for a variety of scenarios.

He further noted the department's ongoing collaboration with local Jewish temples to maintain a proactive approach to campus and property security. Additionally, the department has posted an open officer position and is currently accepting applications from interested candidates.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
